Maryland State Aid – Need Based Grants

- O Howard P. Rawlings Educational Assistance Grant
 - Priority consideration given to FAFSA applicants who complete by March 1
 - Students must be enrolled full-time(12 credits or more at FCC) to be eligible
 - Students must be enrolled in an eligible Associate's Degree program
- Part-Time Grant
 - O Awards range from \$300 to \$450 per semester at FCC
 - Must be enrolled in eligible Associate's Degree program

Maryland State Aid – Tuition Waivers

- O Tuition Waivers
 - Students with Disabilities
 - O For students receiving SSI or SSDI
 - Must self-disclose to your college
 - O Unaccompanied Homeless Youth
 - Contact your college's Financial Aid Office
 - O Must complete the FAFSA by March 1
 - Foster Care Students
 - Must be on the Maryland Foster Care list put on by caseworker
 - Must complete the FAFSA by March 1
