- 3. Evaluate student performance in the clinical setting.
- 4. Provide a formal plan for orientation of assigned unit in the clinical setting.
- 5. Maintain clinical skills in the area of responsibility.
- 6. Develop and assign clinical assignments for students.
- 7. Establish weekly communication with assigned course coordinator.
- 8. Engage students in critical thinking, problem solving, and interpersonal workplace skills.
- 9. Infuse diverse, multicultural perspectives into the instructional process.

- 3. 2 years of clinical experience as a registered nurse
- 4. Successful clinical experience in the area of specialty
