Scholarships are available for FCC students enrolled in courses in Building Trades courses (credit) or non-credit Trades & Vocational Training courses (Electrical, HVAC or Welding). This scholarship is valued at up to \$500. Students can receive one Building Trades Scholarship per semester.

## Eligibility Requirements:

- Recipient must be a Frederick County resident eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- Recipient must be enrolled in a Building Trades course (credit)
- OR, be enrolled in a non-credit Trades & Vocational Training course (Electrical, HVAC or Welding)

## Required Documents:

- Proof of enrollment/registration in at least one Building Trades course (credit) or a non-credit Trades & Vocational Training course (Electrical, HVAC or Welding)
- Proof of residency – 2 items (Acceptable items include: driver's license or state ID; utility, telephone, cable or satellite TV bill; checking, savings or financial account statement; mortgage account statement or deed; current residential rental contract or an apartment lease; mail from a federal, state or local government agency)

Please read and fully complete the application form and submit it with all required documentation at least three weeks before the class start date.
