**Math Courses** Consult an advisor to choose a math course; MA 111 Precalculus, MA 206 Statistics, MA 207 Elementary Statistics with Probability, BU/MA 205 Business Statistics (prerequisite CIS 101, CIS 111E or CIS 116E), MA 130 Foundations of Mathematics with Algebra, MA 201 Applied Calculus, MA 210 Calculus I suggested.

**Elective Courses** Recommend electives may include AN 101, AN 103, BU/MA 205, CIS 101, CJ 108, CJ 109, HS 102, INTR 103, PH 205, SO 101, SO 102, SO 210, SO 212.

### Transfer Institution Information

**University of Maryland College Park** is a limited enrollment program and requires a GPA of 2.5 or better . Only one “gateway” course may be repeated to earn the required grade and that course may be repeated only once (withdraws and audits included). ### Completing the Pathway

Students who take fewer than 15 credits each semester or who require developmental English or math coursework will need additional semesters to complete their degrees. Summer and January term classes may help students to make faster progress.

General Education CORE courses can often be taken in any semester. One course must be designated as a Cultural Competence course. A minimum of nine credits must be taken at the 200 level.
